Q. What is the population of the Lakehead 96051 area?

A. About 2,500

Q. When was the Lakehead Fire Station founded?

A. Company 54 was founded in 1973. Equipment was first borrowed from the US Forest Service and later purchased as local funding efforts succeeded.

Q. When did Lakehead purchase their Jet Craft Fire/Rescue boat?

A. Fall 2000

Q. How long has it been since LVFC 54 responded to emergencies on Lake Shasta?

A. The Jet Craft rescue boat has not responded to an emergency since 2016, because there are not enough volunteer firefighters.

Q. Is Lakehead, CA a city on Shasta Lake?

A. No, Lakehead is not a city. Lakehead is an unincorporated community governed by Shasta County, whose largest city is Redding. Lakehead is located on the northern-most arm of the Sacramento River which

furnishes water to form the reservoir called Shasta Lake. The US Bureau of Reclamation completed Shasta Dam in 1945.

Q. Where is Lakehead, CA?

A. Lakehead is in the 96051 zip code. The recreational community center is 14 miles north of Bridge Bay at the Pitt River Bridge crossing Shasta Lake on Interstate 5. Lakehead is 28 miles north of Redding, CA.
