



HAPPY CAMP RELIEF FUND Disbursements Report

In response to the 2020 Slater Fire, the Happy Camp Relief Fund was activated by the Community Foundation of the North State. This fund is addressing the needs of immediate and long-term recovery for the residents in and around Happy Camp, CA.

Grants Distributed

Funds distributed from this Fund are in the form of grants to local nonprofits and government agencies. Requests are reviewed and approved by staff, a community grant review panel made up of Happy Camp residents and Siskiyou County personnel and approved by the Community Foundation Board of Directors.
