3 Setting Up a Fund

- Contact CFNS to discuss the type of fund that meets your needs:
 - Endowed the fund is invested to grow and grant for perpetuity; a percentage of the fund is made available for you to grant each year
 - Non-endowed the full balance of the fund is available for grantmaking
 - Competitive the fund is open to receive grant applications which are reviewed and selected for grant awards based on your preferred criteria (award minimums apply)
- Name your fund and sign your fund agreement (e-sign available)
- Make a gift to establish your fund with cash, stock, real estate, or other assets
- Determine the fund's advisor(s) and successor advisor(s) (if applicable)
- Add to your fund at anytime, or include the fund in your estate plans
