# THE WOMEN'S FUND

- The Women's Fund mission: Create a better future for women and their families in the Redding-Area
- Serves Redding-area defined as: Cottonwood-within-Shasta Co. (South), Shasta Lake City (North), Palo Cedro (East), and Igo/Ono (West)
- Grant range = \$1,000-\$40,000
- Project based. Programmatic costs/salaries ok.
- Budget is required.
- Awardees will required to present at The Giving Circle event on Nov. 20<sup>th</sup> at 5:30 PM.



# ANIMAL WELFARE ENDOWMENT FUND

- Serves Shasta, Siskiyou, and Tehama Counties
- Grant range = \$1,000 - \$5,000; average grant size \$2,500
- Grants will be made for **general support** (unrestricted!) for organizations whose primary work promotes the welfare of animals in the following categories:
  - **Supporting Homeless Animals and/or Owned Pets** – reducing overpopulation and shelter deaths, keeping pets in homes
  - **Supporting Wildlife** – care of wildlife (rescue/rehab or in nature)
  - **Supporting Working Animals** – care for organizationally-owned animals that provide service to local residents
- No project budget or timeline





# REDDING RANCHERIA COMMUNITY FUND



- Serves Shasta and Trinity Counties
- Grant range = \$1,000 - \$10,000; average award \$2,500
- Grants will be for **general support** (except salaries) and can be used for things like: equipment, programs, services, etc.
- Encourages groups that serve Native Americans, youth and/or rural communities
- Please include quick breakdown of costs in your narrative.

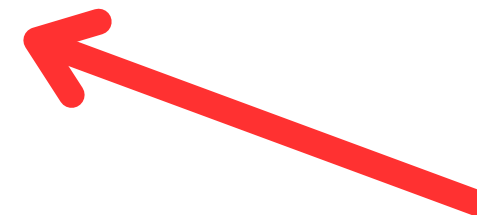

## Redding Rancheria Community Fund (Fall 2025)

*Community Foundation of the North State*

### Grant Information/Parameters

The Redding Rancheria is a federally-recognized Tribe whose members are of the Pit River, Yana and Wintu descent. The Redding Rancheria Community Fund was established to give to and support worthy causes in the surrounding communities. Contributions to this fund come primarily from Win-River Casino, which is owned and operated by the Redding Rancheria.

This Fund encourages proposals to serve Native Americans, youth and/or rural populations. Grants will be awarded for general support and may help with things like capital improvements/renovations, equipment, programs, services, etc. Grants are not awarded to or for: personnel costs/salaries (incl. wages, compensation or contracts for services), individuals, reimbursements (costs incurred prior to signing of awarded grant contract) or start ups costs for organizations that have not yet begun to offer programming.

Grant requests should be between \$1,000 and \$10,000. Recent average grant size is \$2,500; partial funds may occur.

Organizations must serve Shasta and/or Trinity counties.

Eligible organizations include: Nonprofits with a public tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the IRS Code (501c3 nonprofit/public charity), public entities (ex: counties, special districts, federally-recognized tribes), or projects/programs fiscally-sponsored by a nonprofit or public entity.

Organizations with a grant report past due to the Community Foundation are not eligible to apply.

Grant applicants must address The Women's Fund mission to "create a better future for women and their families in the Redding Area". The services provided by organizations funded through grants from The Women's Fund must take place within and include residents of the Redding area which is defined as Cottonwood (within Shasta County) to the South, Shasta Lake City to the North, Palo Cedro to the East, and Igo/Ono to the West.

Grant requests should be between \$1,000 and \$40,000.

Eligible organizations include: Nonprofit, public charities with tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the IRS Code, public entities (ex: counties, special districts, federally-recognized tribes), or projects/programs fiscally-sponsored by a nonprofit or public entity. Organizations are not precluded from applying to The Women's Fund for consecutive years.

Grant awardees will be asked to give a brief presentation at a Women's Fund Giving Circle event, which is typically held the first week of November. Giving Circle participants will vote for one awardee organization to be recipient of unrestricted bonus award from monies raised at event.

# APPLICATION TIPS

## KEEP IT SIMPLE

- *Applications are reviewed by community members.*
- *You have permission to keep it brief & simple.*
- *Don't use work jargon.*
- *Explain acronyms.*
- *Do not need to write to character limit.*
- *Think 1-2 paragraphs.*



## PROJECT NAME



- Please keep it very short! One sentence/phrase telling what/who/where
- Project example: "to create an interactive street theater project in downtown Redding"
- General support example: "for general support to offset rising horse care costs"



P&L/Statement of Activities

- It should represent the closest 12-month time period.
- For example, 7/1/24–6/30/25
- If there is an unusually large net gain or loss (ex: >10% of gross revenue) please explain on the upload what caused this.

  - What are the tangible things you will be able to do, if funded (ex: purchase software, host # of workshops)?
  - Who will you reach with these activities? How many people and who do you expect to serve?
  - Outcomes: changes brought about by project.
  - How will this project create a better future for women and their families in the Redding area in the near future and down the road?
- How will it continue after grant ends?
- Community collaboration
- Timeline
- Budget

Below is a sample budget. You are not required to use this format. Using this layout makes it easy to include expenses for items covered by varied income sources, if it applies to your project.							
* In-Kind includes anything donated including supplies, volunteer time, and vendor discounts.

**The following are examples of how to include a cost breakdown in your narrative:**

- \$3,212.00 for an Elevated Search and Rescue | Motor System, \$650 for a Garmin Astro 900 dog tracking bundle, and \$250 for a second Astro 900 Dog Collar for backup
- We typically spend \$.50/day per child. There are 44 children enrolled in our programs, which is \$22/day. Children attend for 180 days during the school year. The total cost to feed them is \$3960. If awarded the funding, this will provide snacks from August 2025 through June 2026.

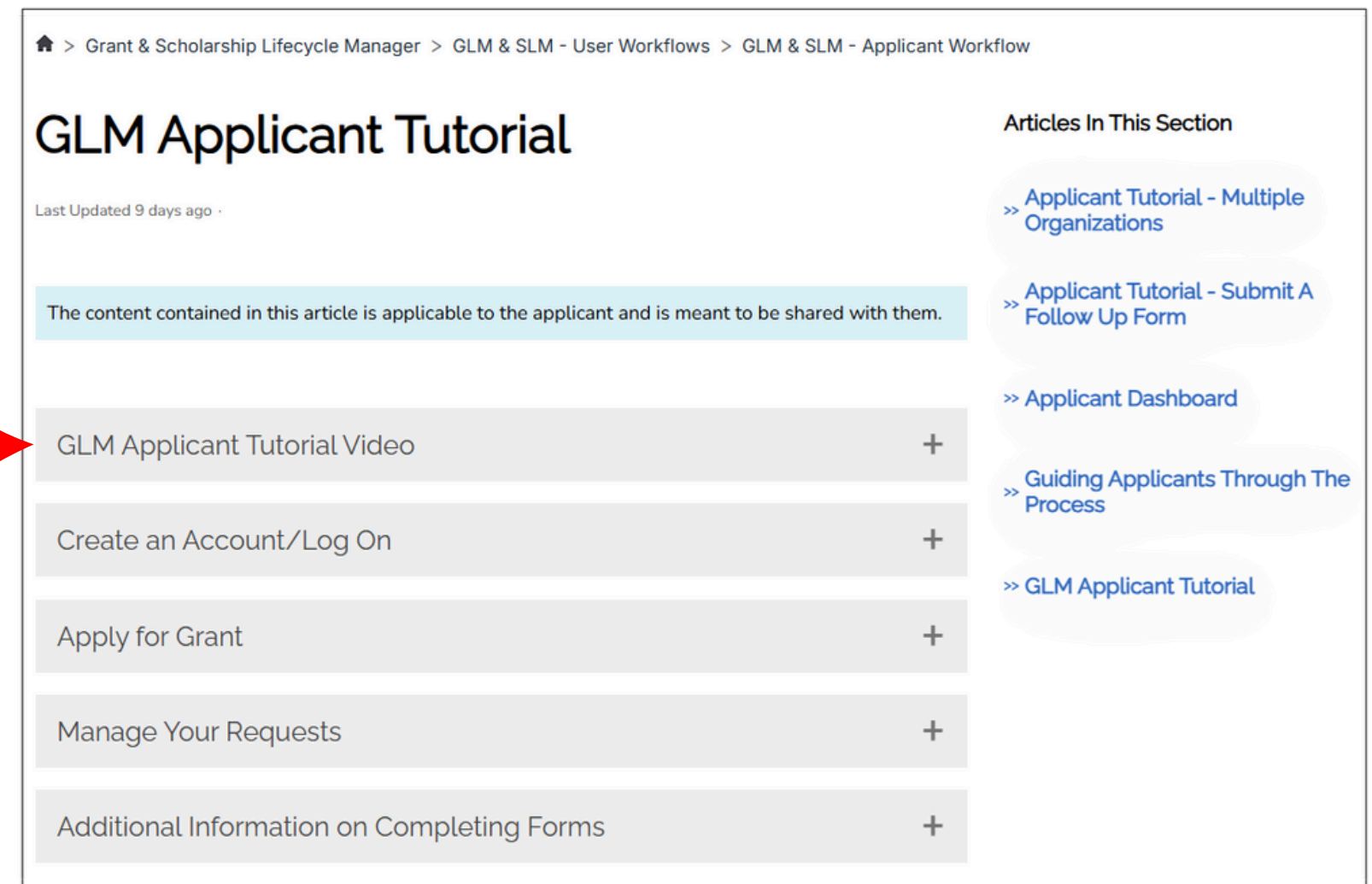

The Redding Rancheria Community Fund was established to give to and support worthy causes in the surrounding communities. Contributions to this fund come primarily from Win-River Casino, which is owned and operated by the Redding Rancheria.

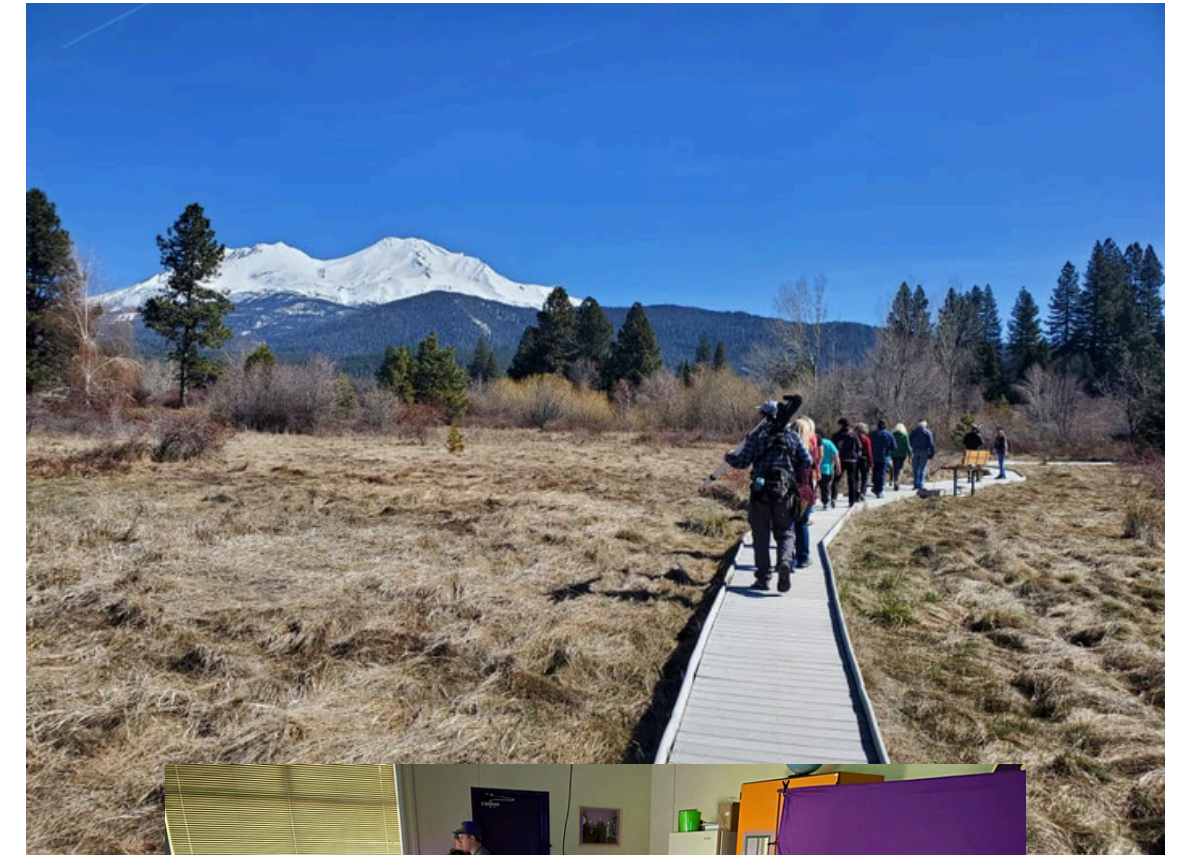
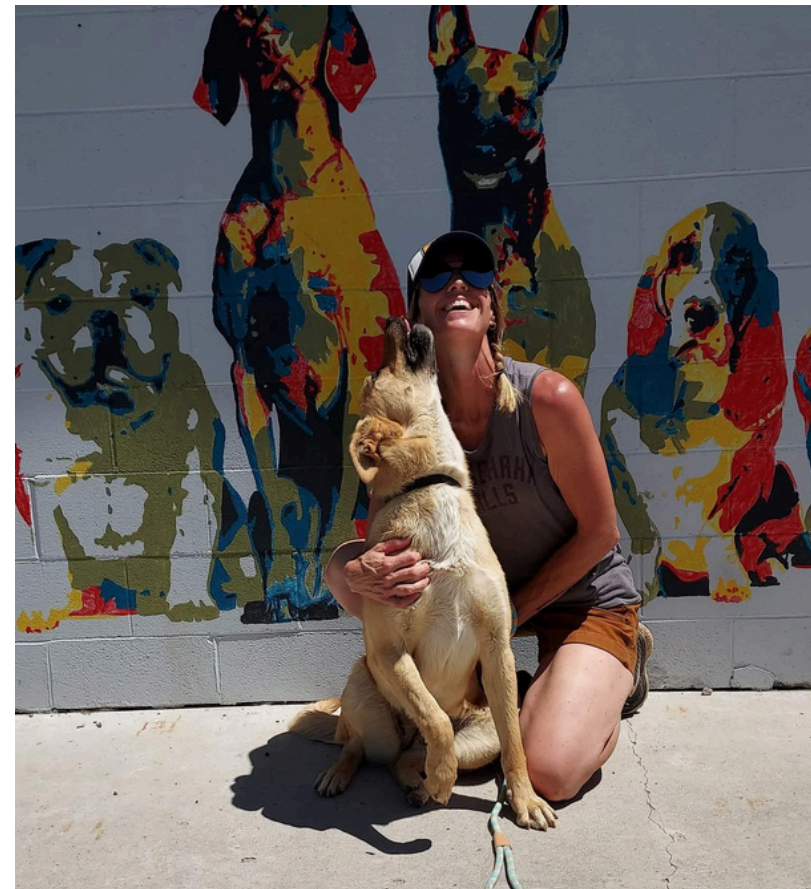

- We conduct due diligence to ensure qualified via Guidestar & Secretary of State
- Applications reviewed by grant panels
- May have follow-up questions. Check your email & junk filter
- Possible site visits, but very few. Not an indicator of funding, just need more information to assess.
- Grant recommendations made by panel. Final approval made by CFNS board.
- Award/denial emails sent via GLM by end of Nov.
- Entire process = approx. 3 months from deadline



# IF MY ORG GETS A GRANT...

- Once agreement signed online, we put in our weekly check queue and mail check for full amount.
- 12 months to complete project and submit grant report ONLINE in portal. You will be auto-emailed reminders.
- Grant reports help us:
  - Tell your story to funders - Send photos that include people (front-facing, photo released)
  - Account for how monies were spent - Submit expenditures in original budget format (or Income & Expense for grant period for general support grants)

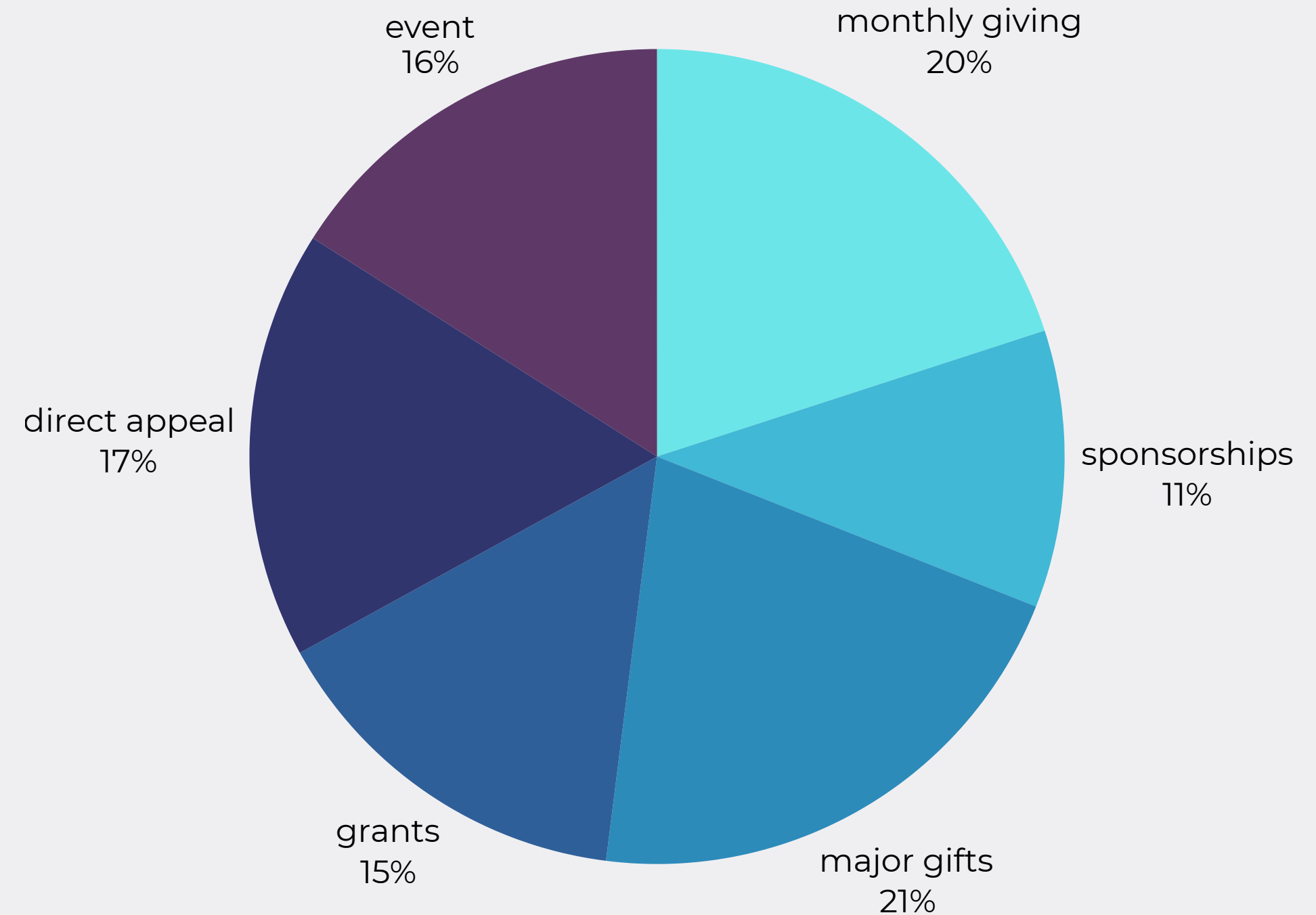

# IF MY ORG DOESN'T GET A GRANT

- We often send unfunded-but-qualified projects to potential donors of interest
- Reach out for feedback. If we have constructive feedback, we will share it with you.
- It's competitive & sometimes there is no constructive feedback. Other needs rose to the top. Redding Rancheria Spring '24: \$400K application requests / \$100K available
- Seek diverse revenues – grants are one slice of funding pie
- Do try again in future rounds (Spring '25)
